1. The Bible is a UNIQUE LIBRARY

It's divided up into two large sections: The **OLD** and **NEW** Testaments

The Old Testament contains four main literature groupings:

- A. **LAW**
- B. **HISTORY**
- C. **WISDOM/POETRY**
- D. **PROPHECY** (Major and Minor Prophets)

The New Testament contains four main literature groupings:

- A. **GOSPELS**
- B. **HISTORY** (Acts)
- C. **EPISTLES** (Letters)
- D. **PROPHECY** (Revelation)

2. The Bible is DIVINELY INSPIRED

2 Timothy 3:16, 2 Peter 1:20-21
