## Summer Road Trip: A Journey into the Bible Sundays Part 6 – 'The Great Adventure': How to Apply the Bible to our Lives

2 Timothy 3:16 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness,

The goal of application is transformation.

When reading the Bible, we can ask: 1. What does it say? 2. What does it mean in context? 3. How does it apply to me?

## Three Keys to Biblical Application

- 1. Good application comes from good interpretation
- 2. Not all passages are applied equally
- 3. We are to apply all passages through <u>Christ</u> and New Covenant realities

## Three Kinds of Biblical Application

- 1. Sometimes 'applying' the Bible isn't about what you "*do*", but what <u>Spiritual Truths</u> you come to "*know*".
- 2. Putting what the Scripture is <u>Plainly Teaching</u> into practice in our lives through obedience.
- 3. Drawing out <u>Eternal Principles</u> from the text to apply in our modern context.

## Three Ways TO Apply, and NOT to Apply the Bible

- 1. The Bible is not a dead <u>Rulebook</u> to be followed, but a revelation of a <u>Living Faith</u> in Christ.
- 2. The Bible is not a <u>Weapon</u> to be used against others, but a <u>Tool</u> to reveal God's love and salvation for all.
- 3. The Bible is not a book of <u>Fortune Cookies</u> that leads us to a quick fix, but a deep book of <u>Wisdom</u> that leads us to unfailing trust.
