This message will give TWO PRINCIPLES about Jesus and the Bible, and TWO WAYS that we can see Jesus in it.

I. TWO PRINCIPLES ABOUT JESUS AND THE BIBLE

1. The Bible is ultimately telling one **UNIFIED STORY**, and that story is about Christ
2. To put the Bible in **PROPER PERSPECTIVE**, we must interpret it through the lens of Jesus

II. TWO WAYS WE CAN SEE JESUS IN ALL OF THE BIBLE

1. Jesus is Seen Through **PROPHECIES** about the **MESSIAH**

Acts 3:24 *“Indeed, beginning with Samuel, all the prophets who have spoken have foretold these days.”*

Genesis 3:15 *“And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel.”*

- The Seed of Abraham
- The Ruler from Judah
- The Prophet Like Moses
- The Suffering Servant
- The Promised King of David
- The Messiah As Priest Forever

2. Jesus is Seen Through **TYPES** and **SHADOWS**

- Jesus is a type of Adam (Romans 5:14)
- Jesus is a type of Noah’s Ark (Genesis 6-9)
- Jesus is a type of Isaac (Genesis 22)
- Jesus is a type of Joseph (Genesis 37-50)
- Jesus is a type of Moses (Acts 3:22)
- The Exodus is a shadow of Jesus (Exodus 12-14)
- The Passover Lamb is a shadow of Jesus (Exodus 12, John 1:29)
- The Sacrificial System is a shadow of Jesus (Hebrews 10:1-10)
- The Bronze Serpent is a shadow of Jesus (Numbers 21:4-9, John 3:14-15)
- The Tabernacle is a shadow of Jesus (Exodus 25-40)
- The Day of Atonement is a shadow of Jesus (Leviticus 16; Hebrews 9:11-12)
